

2021 REMOTE SETTING AQUACULTURE PROGRAM

The Remote Setting Aquaculture (RSA) program is intended to offer new and active Maryland lease holders with the necessary training, equipment and materials to produce their own oysters. Program participants will have access to remote setting equipment, larvae, shell and other supporting services at a discount. The program is not intended to enable a leaseholder to produce all the oysters for their given lease(s) as required by the State.

The oyster production portion of the program is anticipated to operate from June to August in two week increments at six sites around the Bay. Priority will be given to new participants. The RSA program is privately funded by the Ratcliffe Foundation and administered by the Maryland Seafood Cooperative. NEW PARTICIPANTS

- This program is open to all new leaseholders for a maximum of two (2) years
- A leaseholder and their immediate family (with an oyster harvesters license) may only be in the program for a combined total of four (4) years with limited discounts
- Available to purchase discounted larvae and shell (*see pricing below*)

QUALIFIED RSA PARTICIPANTS

Once the participant is no longer considered a new participant, qualified leaseholders may be able to access RSA program facilities on a first come, first serve basis

- This program is available to all approved individuals for a maximum of two (2) years
- A leaseholder and their immediate family (with an oyster harvesters license) may be in the program for a combined total of four (4) years, receiving limited discounts in the last two years
- New participants have priority over returning participants
- Available to purchase discounted shell (*see pricing below*)

MARYLAND SEAFOOD COOPERATIVE PARTICIPANTS

Maryland Seafood Cooperative (MDSC) may access RSA program facilities on a first come, first serve basis. Shell, larvae and tank rental would be available at discount rates.

- New participants have priority over MDSC participants
- Available to purchase discounted larvae and shell (*see pricing below*)

ALL OTHER LEASEHOLDERS

All leaseholders may access the RSA program facilities on a first come, first serve basis

- New participants have priority over Other Leaseholders
- Available to purchase larvae and shell (*see pricing below*)

SHELL

All new, qualified RST and MDSC participants may purchase a total of 2,000 bags per year at the discounted rate from ORP at Horn Point or MDNR at Piney Point. No more than 4,000 bags may be purchased in any given year. Shell may NOT be used for bottom hardening, only setting.

TANK RENTAL

There is a cost to maintain and operate the remote setting tanks. Tank rental will be waived for new participants, qualified RST participants and MDSC members. All other leaseholders will be charged \$50 per tank per set. Checks should be made out to MD Seafood Cooperative.
